

2017 - 2018 Algiers Charter Cell Phone Policy

All electronic devices, inclusive of cell phones, must be powered off and out of sight before entering the campus and may not be used at any point during the school day. Cell phones may not be seen or heard at any point during the school day. Cell phones may not be used during transitions, during lunch, inside or outside of classrooms, on school yards, or during P.E. Compliance with this policy is the student's responsibility. Failure to comply will result in confiscation of the electronic device.

Students who choose to bring electronic devices to school do so at their own risk. Cell phones and electronic devices that are seen, heard, or discovered through inquiry on campus, before, during, or after school hours will be confiscated and subject to the following:

- First Offense:** Parent/Guardian must retrieve the cell phone/electronic device at his/her earliest convenience and sign a "Warning Notice" acknowledging consequences for further infractions
- Second Offense:** Phone/electronic device can be retrieved no sooner than 10 days after the date of the offense.
- Third Offense:** Phone/electronic device can be retrieved no sooner than 30 days after the date of the offense.
- Fourth Offense:** Phone/electronic device can be retrieved no sooner than the last day of school.
